Directions to MetroTech Center

Subway

This is the fast and most convenient way to reach the MetroTech Center. All of the trains listed below stop within a few blocks of the MetroTech Center at the listed stations:

From Penn Station

We would recommend the A train. If people get on the first car, when they exit at Jay Street, they will be right on the corner where the National Grid building is. You just have to turn left onto Jay Street and it's on the left, across from the MTA.

Other Trains

- 2, 3, 4, 5 -- Borough Hall
- A, C, F -- Jay Street/Borough Hall
- B, M,Q, R -- DeKalb Avenue

Bus

All of these bus routes stop within a few blocks of the MetroTech Center:

Long Island Railroad:

The stop closest to MetroTech is Flatbush Avenue. From there, take the 2, 3, 4, or 5 train to Boro Hall, or the M or R train to Lawrence Street, and then walk two blocks to MetroTech. Or:

Take the #41 bus near the LIRR station on Flatbush Avenue to Smith Street and Livingston Streets. Walk along Smith Street one block; it will become Jay Street at the corner of Fulton Street; continue walking along Jay Street two blocks to MetroTech.

You can also walk from the Long Island Railroad's Flatbush Avenue stop to MetroTech (the walk is about 15 - 20 minutes). When you exit the station, walk north along Flatbush Avenue until you reach either Fulton Street or Willoughby Street. If you turn left on Fulton Street, you will be at the beginning of the Fulton Street outdoor mall. Walk along Fulton Street to Jay Street, turn right and walk two blocks to MetroTech. Or, walk on Flatbush Avenue until you reach Willoughby Street and turn left. Continue on Willoughby until you reach Jay Street, turn right and go one block to MetroTech.

Bus (in Brooklyn):

The numbers 25, 26, 38, 41, 52, 54, 65, 67 and 75 all stop within a reasonable distance from the MetroTech area.

By Car:

Take Atlantic Avenue to Smith Street. Turn onto Smith Street traveling north. Continue on Smith Street for two blocks. As you cross Fulton Street, Smith Street will become Jay Street. The office will be two blocks from Fulton Street on the right side of the street. To get to the Payment Area, once you enter the building, make a left. The Customer Service Area is located just past the down escalator.

Via BQE Westbound

Exit Tillary Street, make left onto Flatbush Ave Ext. Make right on Myrtle Avenue. See guard at booth for National Grid parking.

Via BQE Eastbound

Exit Tillary Street and proceed to Flatbush Ave Ext. Make right on Myrtle Avenue. See guard at booth for KeySpan parking.

Via Manhattan Bridge

Exit Flatbush Avenue and take to Tillary Street. Turn right on Tillary and then left on Jay Street. Proceed to One MetroTech Center.

Via Brooklyn Bridge

Exit Adams Street and proceed to Tillary Street. Turn left on Tillary and then right on Jay Street. Proceed to One MetroTech Center.

From LaGuardia Airport

Take the Grand Central Parkway West to the Brooklyn/Queens Expressway (I-278) West to Tillary Street/Manhattan Bridge Exit. Cross the Flatbush Avenue Extension. Turn left on Jay Street, and proceed two blocks -- One MetroTech Center will be on the left hand side.

Parking

An Edison parking garage is located on the C-1 level of MetroTech. The entrance is accessible from Lawrence Street. Parking is also available in the Edison garage in the SIAC building. There are also several other parking facilities along Jay Street.
